Training Team

Clinical Requirements

Nurses are required to complete a clinical requirement for certification with their community after course attendance. This is the responsibility of each individual practitioner. The direct patient care clinical component should complement the classroom educational experience. It provides the registered nurse the opportunity to apply information and skills obtained during class into a clinical experience, and should be completed in a time frame that ensures competency and maximum retention of knowledge and skills learned in class.



Speaker

Renae Diegel, RN, BBL, CEN, CLNC, CMI-III, SANE-A, D-ABMDI, CFN, CFC, is a forensic nurse examiner, a medical death investigator, and the program educator for a forensic nurse examiner program in Macomb County. In her current positions, she provides services that include caring for living patients of sexual assault, domestic violence, child abuse, elder abuse, trauma, and neglect. Additionally, Renae works in coordination with the Michigan State Police Forensic Science Division and the Macomb County Medical Examiner's Office to perform trace evidence collection from the human body at homicide and suspicious deaths scenes.

Her passion for this specialty area of nursing practice shines through her various commitments. She is an active member of the American Academy of Forensic Sciences, is a level III certified medical investigator, a certified forensic nurse, and certified forensic consultant for the American College of Forensic Examiners International. Renae is an integral member of the American Board of Forensic Nurses and also has earned the distinction of Diplomat with the American Board of Medical Death Investigators (ABMDI). She is a respected and sought-after presenter, having shared her forensic nursing expertise with national and international audiences. In addition to being an invited guest speaker at many educational events around the world, Renae also enjoys educating others through her role as a field training educator for the National Forensic Nursing Institute.

Renae's nursing roots are deep—she has extensive experience as an emergency room/trauma nurse. She is a certified emergency nurse, a trauma nurse core curriculum provider, and an emergency pediatric nurse course provider through Emergency Nurses Association and a practicing Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE). Renae will also draw from her legal consulting experiences to provide an interesting and important perspective to these discussions.
